It still does.




The kitchen is complete with stainless steel gas range, sink and a 4 cu. ft. ice box that's accessible even with the top down. The cabinets feature raised decorator fronts and positive locking latches. And the upholstery is made of Herculon to resist spills and wear.


Stardust has our 110/12 volt electric converter system so you can have electricity anywhere. From campground outlet or car battery.

In the Swinger, the kitchen console swings out so you can cook outdoors if you want. And, in both models, the kitchen swings up to a comfortable working height indoors.




The queen-size end bunks have windows with screens. And their roofs are two layers thick with canvas inside and vinyl outside to prevent leaks and block out light.


The Starlite offers a convertible dinette, gaucho and end bunks to sleep seven.

And both models have under 200 lb. hitch weights. So they can be towed by compact cars.



Yet Starlette is a little camper with a big heart.






Steel bumper integrated with the frame for collision protection.

Automotive-type 12" or 13" wheels for easier towing.  
4-ply sandwich walls with styrofoam insulation and aluminum exteriors. Strong, yet lightweight.
